

Why should I play this mod?

This has been a process...

I started this project nearly a year and a half ago at the time of this writing - way back on February 7, 2013. I probably have more than 600 hours into this, certainly more hours than any sane person would have willingly donated.

I began this project simply because I had the urge to replay one of my favorite build ups to a match. Back in 2004, WWE took a career midcarder in Bob Holly and made him look like a legitimate threat to Brock Lesnar - the menacing face of the company and the WWE Champion in a very short time, proving that with the right push behind a guy, the WWE machine is great at getting someone over. Sure, Lesnar botching a powerbomb and legitimately breaking Holly's neck aided to the heat of the feud - but I dare anyway to go back and watch those episodes of Smackdown and tell me Holly didn't look like a legitimate bad ass in that feud!

That's personally why I chose the time period for this mod. But there are plenty of reasons why January makes sense as a starting point. In WWE for instance, you

get to start on the road to WrestleMania. Has the aftermath of the Chris Benoit tragedy soured you on using him in TEW games? The Royal Rumble and WrestleMania main events are wide open at this point!

Elsewhere on the indies, NWA Total Nonstop Action is still holding weekly Pay Per Views where practically anyone can show up. Jeff Jarrett leads a rogues gallery of characters including Don Callis, Abyss, Kid Kash, Glenn Gilberti and David Young against Eric Watts, the NWA, and the rest of TNA. In Ring of Honor, Samoa Joe's path of destruction as Ring of Honor Heavyweight Champion is in full force. And that's just a little bit of what was going on in the US "Big Three" at this point.

As to why should you play this mod? Well hopefully because you're interested in the time period and the challenges it brings!

In the year and a half I've been working on this mod I've tweaked popularity levels to match the suggestions of the Mod Making Guide on the Grey Dog

Software Forums to make sure the game plays as balanced as possible, though suggestions for changes are always welcomed and encouraged. I've also created an EWR inspired "light" angle pack with under 400 angles that should make booking much easier and less time consuming.

But really, I just hope someone else enjoys the mod after all of the hard work that has been put into it.



RETRO EWR GOODNESS!

Those of you the played Extreme Warfare Revenge for hours on end will be in for a pleasant surprise with this mod as it is packed with EWR inspired goodies!

For instance, the angle pack that is included with the mod makes use of 353 basic angles similar to those included in EWR 4.2 and organized the very same way as they were in that game.

In addition, everyone's favorite booking duo of Adam Ryland and that super helpful assistant Sophie have been included as user avatars to choose at the start of each game.

Remember These Guys?



Remember how if you were lucky enough everyone's favorite duo of albino rodents would pop up in a game? Pinky's Narf Poit Wrestling and Brain's World Domination Wrestling

have been included as future promotions in the mod. If you want to open up the possibility of either mouse showing up in the game, just leave them both in as active characters in the game world at the start of your game. (Due to the way TEW 2013 works, that means Pinky and The Brain could also become bookers of existing promotions and cause even more mayhem!)

Be sure to be on the lookout for other EWR inspired easter eggs!

Before You Fire Up a Game



In the interest of keeping "realness" and not wanting to see Sting signed up by WWE in play throughs, a Simmering Tension Relationship has been added between Sting and Vince McMahon.

Since Brock Lesnar and Bill Goldberg were both on their ways out of WWE by WrestleMania, a simmering tension relationship has been added for each of them with Vince McMahon as well. This usually prevents the AI from keeping them post WrestleMania (but in some testing the WWE is still able to resign them so it's a toss up) and both men usually end up in New Japan Pro Wrestling.

If you disagree with these decisions, simply go into the editor and delete those relationships before you begin a game.

Holly's Revenge



Heading into 2004 one of the hottest storylines on Smackdown was Bob Holly's mission for revenge against the WWE Champion Brock Lesnar. Their rivalry could be dated back to September 12, 2002 edition of SmackDown, when Lesnar defeated Holly in a non-title match and injured him by breaking his neck with a powerbomb, putting him out of action for over a year.

A year later, at the Survivor Series, Holly returned to WWE to take revenge from Lesnar, promising to not only make his life a living hell but to put Lesnar through the same torture he went as Holly vowed to break Lesnar's neck. On November 20 edition of SmackDown, Holly was fired by the General Manager Paul Heyman for attacking Lesnar. On the December 18 edition of SmackDown, Heyman announced that Holly would team with Shannon Moore in a tag team match against A-Train and Matt Morgan, in which Holly could get a match of his choosing if he won but if he lost, his WWE contract would be terminated. Holly and Moore won the match, allowing Holly to wrestle a match of his choosing.


